Course Description and Learning Objectives

This 5-day course will provide an intensive and comprehensive overview of most of the major areas of importance to physicians preparing for the American Osteopathic Board of Internal Medicine Certifying Examination (September 13, 2012) and Recertifying Examination (September 14, 2012). It will also provide a thorough overview of major areas of internal medicine. Special emphasis will be placed on recent advances in various subspecialty areas in internal medicine and clinical skills management as they pertain to clinical practice and the examinations.

Several "Board-type" questions will be included during each lecture to improve registrants' readiness to respond to examination questions.
