## Registration Information

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### EDUCATION SESSION FEES

Fees for the 2011 education sessions are based on ACOI membership status and length of time in practice. Active members (training completed prior to 6/30/06) pay \$645; Young Internists (training completed 6/30/06 or later) pay \$545; Emeritus and Retired members pay \$545; Residents and Fellows pay \$100 (waived for Research Contest entrants). Non-member Physicians pay \$895; Non-Physician Health Care Professionals may register for the ACOI member rate of \$645. There is no charge for students. Spouse/guest registration is \$100. **These fees include a \$50 early registration discount, which applies until September 21, 2011. Registrations received after that date do not qualify for the discount.**

### WHAT DOES REGISTRATION INCLUDE?

Physician registration for the Convention includes entry to all education sessions and the Exhibit Hall, daily continental breakfast and luncheon symposia. Luncheon seating is limited. Physician registration also includes all special spouse/guest functions, including one ticket to the Opening Reception. Spouse/Guest registration includes entry to the education sessions, daily continental breakfast in the Exhibit Hall, and all social events, including one ticket to the Opening Reception. (Due to limited seating, guests may not attend the luncheon symposia.) Physician and Spouse/Guest registrations provide the right to purchase off-site tour tickets.

### HOTEL INFORMATION

The JW Marriott San Antonio Hill Country Resort and Spa is the headquarters hotel for the ACOI 2011 Annual Convention and Scientific Sessions. All educational and social events will take place there. ACOI has arranged a discounted room rate of \$254 per night (single/double). Additional local taxes apply. Early reservations are suggested as the hotel is likely to sell out and does not have to honor ACOI's discounted rates after September 21, 2011.
