As you may be aware, eligibility for the honorary degree of Fellow in the American College of Osteopathic Internists (FACOI) is available to physicians who have been certified in internal medicine by the AOBIM or ABIM and are Active members of the ACOI for at least two years.

A letter of recommendation must be made in writing by a primary sponsor (current ACOI Fellow) and endorsed by a second physician colleague, who may or may not be a Fellow of the ACOI.
