I write with regard to nominations of new members to the ACOI College of Fellows. In accordance with the Bylaws of the College, the Honors and Awards Committee will consider nominees for fellowship on the basis of the following criteria: active membership in good standing for the **two-year period** preceding nomination; certification by the American Osteopathic Board of Internal Medicine or the American Board of Internal Medicine; possession of an active medical license in good standing; demonstration of continuing professional accomplishments and scholarship, and documentation of continuing professional activities. If you are aware of individuals who possess these criteria, I urge you to nominate them for this important recognition.

I have enclosed a nomination form and list of physicians eligible to become Fellows on October 23<sup>rd</sup> at the 2020 Annual Convention, which will take place October 21 - October 25 at the Marco Island Marriott Beach Resort in Marco Island, FL. Each nominee for the degree of Fellow must be endorsed by a primary sponsor who must be an active member of the college as well as a fellow and one additional sponsor who is a physician colleague (does not have to be a member of the ACOI). Please send your letters of recommendation directly to those you are sponsoring so they can attach it with their application when submitting.

I encourage you to review this list and nominate whomever you deem appropriate. **If you will be a primary sponsor, nominating forms with your signature and a letter of recommendation must be sent to your nominee before the deadline of June 30, 2020 for your nominee to submit a complete file in time.**
