As you may be aware, eligibility for the honorary degree of Fellow in the American College of Osteopathic Internists (FACOI) is available to physicians who have been certified in internal medicine by the AOBIM or ABIM and are active members of the ACOI for at least two years (dues in good standing two years prior to applying).

I have taken the liberty of enclosing a nominating form for your convenience. To be considered for induction during the ACOI's Annual Convention and Scientific Sessions held October 21-25 at the Marco Island Marriott Beach Resort in Marco Island, FL, **please submit ALL completed nominating materials as one attachment to Claudette A. Jones via email (claudette@acoi.org) no later than June 30, 2020.** Items needed for submission: complete application form with nominee, primary and secondary sponsor's signature, one letter of recommendation from your primary sponsor who must be a current ACOI member and Fellow and your current CV. Your secondary sponsor does not have to be an ACOI member or Fellow and they do not have to submit a letter of recommendation. They must be a physician (DO or MD) and review/sign your application.

Please note, you must be present at the ceremony in order to receive your designation. If you are accepted and can't attend the ceremony, your application will be held for 3 years.
