Program Director Requirements

- Must attend Congress for Resident Trainers each year (usually 1st weekend in May.)
- Each July, the ACOI will send out a Residency Survey to all program directors. This must be completed and returned to the ACOI by the designated date.
- Annual Reports must be completed for all residents/fellows by July 31st. Fines of \$150, per delinquent report, will be imposed after that date.
- Distribute an updated copy of the *Basic Standards for Residency Training in Internal Medicine* to all residents in the program. The *General Standards for Fellowship Training in Internal Medicine Subspecialties* and the specific standards should be distributed to all fellows in the program.
- Complete the registration form for the In-Service Examination and return to the ACOI by the designated date. Please note that the In-Service Exam is ALWAYS given on the first Friday in March. DO NOT schedule outrotations or leave for any resident during that time.
