PC 1: Osteopathic Principles for Patient Care

1. Evaluation of observed resident performance

2. Self-Reflection

- a. Require the resident to reflect and write/discuss a case in which he/she incorporated the four tenets of osteopathic medicine in a case. The reflection should include details of how this was reflected in the history/PE and care plan of the patient.
 - i. The residents reflection could be reviewed during a faculty/PD semi-annual evaluation
 - ii. Faculty/PD would have to assess the level of supervision the resident needed to incorporate these tenets (see above scale)

3. Review of records

- a. The resident could be responsible for bringing a copy of his/her patient note during a semi-annual evaluation. The resident can choose a case that he/she thinks best reflects incorporation of the osteopathic tenets into the care of the patient.
 - i. Faculty/PD would have to assess the level of supervision the resident needed to incorporate these tenets (see above scale)
